Our Marlin swimmers visited Ohio this past weekend to participate in the Great Lakes Zone Championship and they put on quite a show. We finished 6th out of a total of 89 teams! We were part of a dominating Michigan performance that saw six of the top seven teams from Michigan. The scores of the top 10 were as follows:

We had numerous great swims and crowned a new Zone champion. Aaron Shields returns home as a double zone champion winning both the 50 and 100 yard freestyles. Aaron set team records in both of his events. Our 11 & 12 year olds were lead by Nicole Hranchook whose great weekend was highlighted by an amazing 200 IM that would have placed top six at this years High School county meet. Emily Miller was amazing in her 100 breastroke placing top 8 and turning in another time that would have placed at county. Marah Pugh demonstrated the ultimate team spirit by battling through a 103 degree temperature to place in numerous events and hold down the fort in the relays. Kaylyn Budnick rounded out this age group with her incredible relay swims. On the boys side, Jeff Voss lead the attack with six top 8 swims that included team records in the 100 free, the 200 free, and the 50 breastroke. Zack Melcher did battle with distinction in this incredibly tough age group while Kurt Schnell and Townsend Montgomery did yeoman's work on the relays. In the 13 & 14 age group, as said, Aaron Shields was incredible while Mack Biggert was scoring points with blazing fast swims all weekend long. Ben had an eye opener of swim in the 200 fly and Craig was pulling in points the whole weekend. Mike Moore had a great 100 backstroke and Matt Victor pulled in valuable points in the 200 breaststroke. Patrick Alfes did battle in the grueling 200 back and Alex Wagenhals was excellent in both medley relays. Kevin Engelman joined Ben with a great 200 fly. Brad Hunt got stronger and stronger as the weekend went along swimming breaststroke in five events. Eric Platte was very strong in the 800 free relay and the 500 while Jon Rogers swam great in his relay events. And last but certainly not least our lone 10 & under Ben Pitlock put in an amazing swim in the 50 back. Coming in seeded 30th, Ben dropped a second and a half and ended up placing 12th, WOW! Great job swimmers.

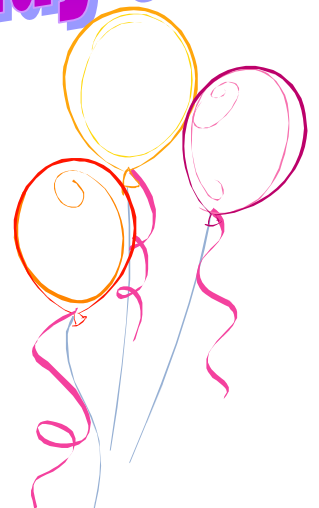
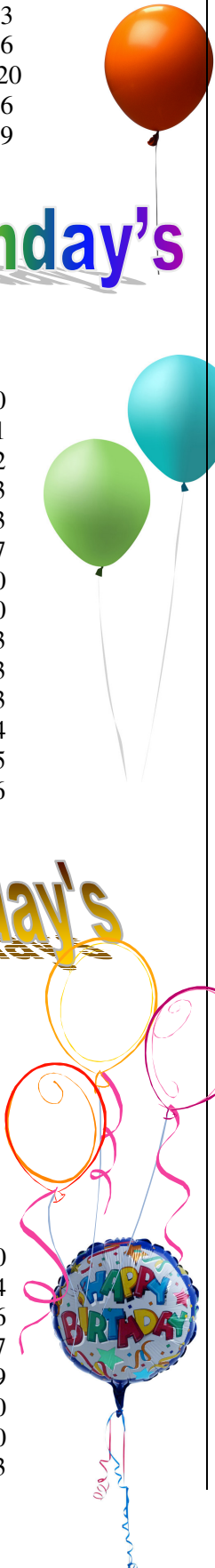
